

## Description

Reacts with a 120 kD type I transmembrane glycoprotein expressed on in-vitro stimulated T and B cells. CD30 is an activation marker which was initially identified on Reed-Sternberg cells and is also expressed on a few extrafollicular T and B cells located at the rim of germinal centers. It is a cytokine receptor which belongs to the nerve growth factor receptor/tumor necrosis factor receptor (NGFR/TNFR) superfamily. CD30 interaction with CD30 ligand (CD30L) can mediate signals for proliferation, apoptosis and cytotoxicity of lymphoid cells.

## **Preparation and Storage**

The monoclonal antibody was purified from tissue culture supernatant or ascites by affinity chromatography.

The antibody was conjugated with R-PE under optimum conditions, and unconjugated antibody and free PE were removed by gel filtration chromatography.

Store undiluted at 4° C and protected from prolonged exposure to light. Do not freeze.
