

Description

The B21.5 antibody reacts with the Vβ 10 T-Cell Receptor (TCR) of mice having the b haplotype (e.g., A, AKR, BALB/c, CBA, C3H/He, C57BL, C58, DBA/1, DBA/2) of the Tcrb gene complex. It does not react with mice having the a (e.g., C57BR, C57L, SJL, SWR) or c (e.g., RIII) Tcrb haplotype.



Two-color analysis of the expression of V\$ 10[b] TCR on peripheral lymphocytes. C57BL/6 lymph node cells were incubated simultaneously with PE-conjugated B21.5, FITC-conjugated RM4-5 (anti-CD4, Cat. No. 553046/553047), and FITC-conjugated 53-6.7 (anti-CD8a, Cat. No. 553030/553031) monoclonal antibodies. Flow cytometry was performed on a FACScan $^{\mathsf{TM}}$ (BDIS, San Jose, CA).

Preparation and Storage

The monoclonal antibody was purified from tissue culture supernatant or ascites by affinity chromatography.

The antibody was conjugated with R-PE under optimum conditions, and unconjugated antibody and free PE were removed by gel filtration chromatography.

Store undiluted at 4° C and protected from prolonged exposure to light. Do not freeze.

Application Notes

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Flow cytometry Routinely Tested

Recommended Assay Procedure:

For flow cytometry of cell suspensions from peripheral lymphoid tissues, it is recommended that multicolor staining be performed to distinguish T lymphocytes from non-T cells. PE has been reported to bind mouse B cells via FcyII receptors. For immunostaining of mouse cells, this binding can be prevented by preincubating cells with Mouse FC BlockTM (Cat. No. 553141/553142).
