FORM

This polyclonal antibody is supplied as a 400 µL aliquot at a concentration of 0.25 mg/mL in phosphate buffered saline (pH 7.4) containing 0.1% sodium azide. This antibody is epitope-affinity purified from rabbit antiserum.

IMMUNOGEN

Synthetic peptide derived from the N-terminal region of the mouse and human gp96 protein, also known as glucose-regulated protein-94 (GRP94), endoplasm, endoplasmic reticulum protein-99 (ERP-99), or polymorphic tumor rejection antigen-1.

SPECIFICITY

This antibody reacts with the mouse, rat, and human gp96 proteins. On Western blots, it identifies a single band at ~96 kDa.

REACTIVITY

Reactivity has been confirmed with mouse and rat brain homogenates by Western blotting and immunoprecipitation, and with formalin-fixed, paraffin-embedded (FFPE) human tonsil tissue by immunohistochemistry. Based on 100% amino acid sequence identity at the immunogen sequence, reactivity with pig, cow, and dog gp96, as well as with chicken Hsp108, is expected.

USAGE

Working concentrations for specific applications should be determined by the investigator. The following concentration ranges are recommended starting points for this product.

ELISA: 0.1-1.0 µg/mL
Western Blotting: 1-3 µg/mL
Immunoprecipitation: 1-5 µg/mL
Immunohistochemistry*: 0.5 – 1.0 µg/mL

* For immunohistochemistry with formalin-fixed, paraffin-embedded (FFPE) tissues, heat induced epitope retrieval (HIER) with EDTA, pH 8.0, is required prior to staining.

STORAGE

Store at 2-8°C for up to one month. Store at -20°C for long-term storage. Avoid repeated freezing and thawing.

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BACKGROUND

The tumor rejection antigen (gp96), also known as glucose-regulated protein 94 (GRP94), is a member of the heat shock protein (HSP) family. The gp96 protein is up-regulated by stress conditions such as glucose starvation and heat shock², and its function is regulated through a ligand-dependent conversion from an active to an inactive conformation⁶. gp96 is involved in both innate and adaptive immunity.⁵ A study has shown that a B-cell line deficient in gp96 is unresponsive to microbial stimuli because toll-like receptors (TLRs) are retained intracellularly. However, normal surface levels of TLRs were restored when these cells were transfected with a cDNA encoding gp96.⁴ The tumor rejection antigen can activate the release of nitric oxide by antigen presenting cells (APCs)³ and it also has a relevant role in the regulation of immune responses to pathological cell death.¹
